	Centres have 61,528 registered members, an increase of 16%.
	• Introducing digital membership cards, available via the app. Will need to request a physical card if you want one.
	 Experience Freedom - in 2022, 10 sites will be offering 8 types of accommodation, 90 units in total. Wide range including holiday cottages, yurts, glamping, universally accessible units. Feedback indicates appealing to younger outdoor lovers plus members and friends and family. 2000+ rallies already uploaded onto website and included in brochure. Centres must keep information up to date, do let Club know re changes or cancellations. Provision of EHU on rallies / events. Club kit based in West Midlands. Stock has been reviewed and tested, information will be circulated as to what is available and costs involved, including fuel and transport. Can no longer use red diesel after April (change in law). The new booking capability system to be rolled out in Q2, probably in the later months. Deposits will be required. Temporary site planned at Beaulieu, in June and then again in August. Plan to plant 2022 trees across the sites during the year as part of the Queen's Green Canopy initiative; the first 5 had been planted at Chapel Lane.
2.	 Rallying: There was an extensive discussion on rallying and how to encourage new members to join centres and join a rally.
3.	Website & Facebook pages:
	• There were currently 571 followers on the regional Facebook pages, more than most regional sites.
	• The regional website had recorded 590 visitors since the regional AGM in October, about 20% increase on last year.

The Chairman David Rickard and Vice-Chairman David Baber would be present and planned to have information on rallies available and photos from previous rallies to illustrate what happens on a rally to raise awareness and encourage participation.
